


As part of **Be Safe** week we have discussed how we keep our bodies safe by hand washing. We have discussed how germs spread and the importance of handwashing. The children completed an experiment using glitter to represent the germs like 'Stinky Foot Syndrome' or 'Spotty Eared Flu'. 😊 The children covered their hands in glitter and then shook hands with their friends to watch how it spread. The children then washed their hands with just water and then with soap. We talked about the importance of using soap. Why not practise hand washing at home?

For shape, space and measure this week the children have been looking and talking about different sized objects. They have used the vocabulary:-

“The .....is bigger/ smaller than the.....”


“The .....is longer/ shorter than the.....”
